

## Key Messages – Alliance Leadership Team (ALT)



<b>Memo to:</b>	Key South Island Alliance stakeholders
<b>Purpose of memo:</b>	To provide a brief summary of the key messages from the most recent South Island Alliance Leadership Team meeting.
<b>ALT meeting date:</b>	Monday 13 August 2018
<b>1</b>	<p><b>Training for SLA and workstream chairs</b></p> <p>ALT recommended refining the training session for South Island service level alliance (SLA) and workstream chairs. The session will focus on strengthening their mandate to lead, and their role in helping drive the health system around strategic priorities, with equity being the top priority. The chair’s training session will take place at a later date.</p>
<b>2</b>	<p><b>South Island Alliance strategic planning day</b></p> <p>Preparations are underway for the South Island Alliance strategic planning day in October. The one-day event for chief executives, SLA and workstream chairs, and SIAPO staff, will build on last year’s event with a focus on clear, agreed outcomes. It will include progress updates from SLAs and workstreams, progress towards our one-to-two year priorities, achievements over the last few years and next steps. The day will also allow for strategic discussion between CEs and SLA and workstream chairs about progress towards the Alliance’s strategic priorities.</p>
<b>4</b>	<p><b>South Island Health Services Plan</b></p> <p>ALT provided feedback on the South Island Health Services Plan, which provides a framework for future planning and outlines our strategic direction, priorities, clinical leadership and work programme for 2018/19, and our direction for the following two years. A draft has also been submitted to the Ministry of Health with no feedback received to date.</p>
<b>5</b>	<p><b>South Island Alliance Operational Group</b></p> <p>ALT discussed the terms of reference and membership of the GMs P&amp;F/COO/CMO group. This group has been renamed the South Island Alliance Operational Group (SIAOG). It reports to ALT and its role is to operationalise strategy. Membership includes GMs P&amp;F and COOs; CMO, Director of Nursing and Director of Allied Health representatives; South Island Alliance general manager; and others on a case-by-case basis. The chair is yet to be decided.</p>
<b>6</b>	<p><b>Alliance communications</b></p> <p>ALT supported the need to update the South Island Alliance website and communicate the Alliance’s key priority areas. More engagement with DHB communications teams was also encouraged. Note: a South Island communications mini conference is being held on 23-24 August including Alliance and DHB communications teams.</p>
