

Calderdale Framework: bringing the wider team on board

Allied Health projects using the Calderdale Framework are progressing in each of the 5 South Island District Health Boards. Projects are interdisciplinary and involve the wider team in service analysis and task analysis to ensure that increased use of allied health assistants or skill sharing between disciplines is appropriate to skill sets and the patient pathway.

As part of bringing the wider team on board for this and future projects, Canterbury DHB Calderdale Framework Facilitators Annette Howard and Sandy Clemett ran a Foundation Day training session at the Riley Day Hospital on April 11. Foundation Day training has been offered by Calderdale Framework Facilitators across the South Island DHBs in the last year. The next Calderdale Framework Foundation Day currently planned is in South Canterbury DHB on May 19th.
