3 Health and Disability System Review

The final report is due with the Minister by the end of March 2020 and is expected to be released shortly after that.

4 Regional visualisation tool

Representatives from EY presented to the Alliance Board and ALT the latest iteration of the regional visualisation tool. This product pulls regional data from a wide variety of national datasets and provides the ability to model and forecast different scenarios. It is now being tested by business analysts in the five South Island DHBs to determine how it can best be used, what value it provides and the next steps. They are due to report back to the Board and ALT in February.

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
